

CALL FOR KOROWAI TUPU RŌPŪ MEMBER NOMINATIONS

Korowai Tupu is calling for nominations of Rōpū Members. Every year 3 places on the rōpū become available for election. This year all 3 existing holders of these positions will be standing for re-election.

Details for the Korowai Tupu rōpū are as follows:

- 2-year terms (maximum of 3 terms per person), staggered so that half of the rōpū is up for election each year.
- Maximum of 7 people, one of whom is an appointed board representative.
- Elections will coincide with the Ara Taiohi Board election. You are able to nominate yourself. Only members of Korowai Tupu are eligible to be elected onto the rōpū. Anyone who is a member or has applied for membership is eligible to vote for rōpū members.
- To be eligible for election, nominated members must complete and return a nomination form by **Monday 10 October, 10am**.
